Vietnam & Cambodia Tour

(21 days - Departures: Daily)

Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

Arrive at Noi Bai International airport. We will collect you from arrivals with your name on a board to transfer you to the Hanoi Old Quarter. Have lunch/dinner on your account.

Overnight at hotel in Hanoi.

Day 2: Hanoi City Tour – Departure (B/L)

After breakfast, you will check out & put your luggage at lobby of hotel.

08:00-08:30: We will pick you up at your hotel in the Hanoi Old Quarter. We'll visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and Museum. Discover the architectural and historical aspects of Uncle Ho's final resting-place. Just next door is Ho Chi Minh's house (on stilts) and lying to one side of the Mausoleum is the One Pillar Pagoda that was built by King Ly Thai To in 1049. The structure has become an important symbol for Hanoians. Continue on to visit the Quan Thanh Temple (Taoist dating from the Ly Dynasty) and the Buddhist Tran Quoc Pagoda on West Lake (one of the oldest pagodas in Vietnam). We'll have lunch here.

PM: After lunch, proceed to visit the Ethnology Museum, the Literature Temple and Quoc Tu Giam (Vietnam's first university constructed in 1070, its gardens and well-preserved architecture offering a peaceful glimpse into Vietnam's past). We will take you past Hoan Kiem Lake to see the calm waters and then visit Ngoc Son temple. To end the tour we'll take a coach trip into the Hanoi Old Quarter. You are free until 1530 to explore, relax and shop, in the evening enjoy the Water Puppet Show at Thang Long Theatre. Have supper on your account.

Overnight in your hotel.

Day 3: Hanoi – Hoa Lu – Tam Coc – Hanoi (B/L)

07:45 – 08:15: We will pick you up at your hotel in the Hanoi Old Quarter, then take a coach to Hoa Lu (2.5 hours). Visit the historic capital of Vietnam that's home to the famous ancient temples of the Le and Dinh Dynasties. Take a bus trip or cycle for an hour on the picturesque roads, you'll see peaceful villages, rice fields, rivers and rocky outcrops before arriving at Tam Coc (12km) for a refreshing lunch.

PM: Boat trip to visit Tam Coc to see the fantastic beauty of the towering karsts formations as you drift through them, before rowing into one of the many caves carved into the limestone. Drive back to 49 Hang Be street, Hoan Kiem District, Hanoi city at 18:00.

Have dinner at your account.

20:00: We will transfer you to Hanoi's train station for departure to Sapa (schedule: 21:15 – 06:15). Overnight on the train in an A/C sleeper cabin.

Day 4: Lao Cai – Cat Cat – Sin Chai Villages (B/L/D)

06:15: We collect you at Lao Cai Station, then transfer you to Sa Pa town. You will have breakfast at a local restaurant. We'll then check into an available hotel before 1200. After lunch, we trek to visit the villages of Cat Cat and Sin Chai, home to the Black H'Mong tribe. Here you will see Cat Cat's majestic waterfall and see the beautiful scenery along the way. Then return to the hotel for dinner and a night in Sa Pa town .

Day 5: Lao Chai – Ta Van Villages – Lao Cai Station (B/L)

After having breakfast, you will check out and leave your luggage in the hotel, ready to enjoy a fun and exciting day. Begin by walking down to Lao Chai village; to visit the Tay and Day tribes, then keep going along the

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bottom of the Sapa valley to arrive at Ta Van village which is supposed to be the most beautiful in the area. Have a picnic lunch on the way. You can then get back to Sapa by motorbike/jeep. We'll take you by car to Lao for dinner on your account.

Overnight in the A/C sleeper cabin on the way back to Hanoi (scheduled: 20:15 – 04:30).

Day 6: Hanoi – Ha Long (B/L/D)

06:30: We will pick you up at the Station and transfer you to 49 Hang Be street, Hoan Kiem Dist. Have breakfast on your account.

08:00: We will leave Hanoi for Ha Long City in a modern bus. Here we board a luxury junk boat and enjoy a welcome drink and lunch of savory local sea food. Check into your cabin and start cruising around the bay to see the amazing karsts composed in different formations such as: the Lion, Tea Pot, Toad, and the Dau Nguoi (Human Head) islet, and then stop for an enjoyable walk through the Sung Sot “amazing” cave. There will be plenty of free time for kayaking, swimming and sunbathing (weather permitting) after the boat anchors. Enjoy a wonderful sunset dinner in a restaurant before retiring to the comfort of your cabin. Have dinner and stay overnight on Boat.

Day 7: Ha Long – Hanoi (B/L)

07:15: Cakes, fruits, tea and coffee will be served. Continue to cruise through Ha Long Bay.

09.30 – 10.30: Enjoy a delicious lunch after you pack your things and leave the cabin.

11.30 – 12.00: Sail back to Ha Long pier and take a bus back to Hanoi.

16:15: Arrive at 49 Hang Be Street, Hoan Kiem Dist, Hanoi. You are free there to have dinner on your account.

18:00: We will take you to the Train Station. Overnight to Da Nang city (Scheduled 19:00 – 10:30)

Day 8: Da Nang City Tour (L/D)

10:30: Arrive in Da Nang. We'll pick you up for lunch – enjoy the special Da Nang food and check in at the hotel. Here you can go to the Cham Sculpture Museum and make an excursion around the Son Tra peninsula (Monkey Mountain) to visit the Linh Ung Pagoda, enjoy some swimming at My Khe beach – classed as one of the most attractive beaches on earth by Forbes. In the evening enjoy a “Gala Dinner” - an exciting game show night. You are free to explore Da Nang City and relax.

Overnight in the hotel in Da Nang city.

Day 9: Marble Mountain – Hoi An Ancient Town (B/L/D)

Have Breakfast at the hotel. Then visit Marble Mountain – named after the 5 elements of the universe and the stone carving village of Hoa Hai. Depart for Hoi An ancient town to have lunch and check-in at the hotel. Take a walking tour around the oldest sections – they are charming and wonderfully preserved, combining Chinese, Japanese and European influences) then enjoy some traditional music at 15:15. Explore and relax at Cua Dai Beach and have dinner at a nearby restaurant. You are free to discover the Hoi An “ancient night”, you can immerse yourself in the 17th century, relax, shop and soak up the atmosphere.

Overnight in the hotel in Hoi An city.

Day 10: Hoi An – Hue Imperial City (B/L/D)

Have breakfast and check-out. Leaving Hoi An for Hue Imperial City we travel through the Hai Van tunnel and then stop at the top of the Cloud – Ocean pass, with its fantastic view of Lang Co fishing village. Have lunch and check-in at the hotel.

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In the afternoon, continue on to visit the Imperial Citadel (a grand palace of the last Nguyen dynasty) and see the Heavenly-Goddess pagoda. Have dinner at a restaurant and take a dragon boat trip to hear the Hue folksong on the Perfume River.

Overnight in hotel in Hue city.

Day 11: Hue – Nha Trang (B)

After breakfast, you are free until 10:00AM. Your train will depart at 10:45, and arrive in Nha Trang city at 22:00. Have lunch & dinner on your account. Then you will take a taxi to your proposed hotel in Nha Trang city.

Overnight in Nha Trang city.

Day 12: Nha Trang Boat Trip & Diving Tour (B/L)

08:00 – 8:30: We'll collect you at your hotel and take you to the harbor.

09:30: Visit Bamboo Island, where you can swim, snorkel and sunbathe.

11:30: Visit Mot Island, and enjoy a lunch of fresh seafood. Then relax and enjoy the floating bar with some red wine and pineapple.

14:30: Head to Tranh Beach and sample some seasonal fruit on the boat.

15:45: Visit the Tri Nguyen Aquarium to see different kinds of fish and marine life. You can also buy some special souvenirs for your trip.

16:00: Return to the harbor and head back to the hotel.

Overnight in Nha Trang city.

Day 13: Ho Chi Minh City Tour (B/L)

06:15: We will transfer you to the airport – for a flight that departs at 07:45 for Ho Chi Minh city

08:40: Pick up at the airport. Then join a city tour to visit the Reunification Hall, which was the residence of the President of the former South Vietnam until 1975. You will see many interesting things such as: formal meeting rooms, private bedrooms, war situation rooms 10 meters underground.

This address today still holds many important functions in HCMC. We will have guide who speaks your language to tell you the important historical facts about this building and some famous French colonial structures including the Notre Dame Cathedral (constructed in 1877), the General Post Office, the City Hall, and the War Crime Museum.

Afternoon: Visit China town (the biggest Chinese community in Vietnam) and the Binh Tay wholesale market. We'll stop for a while at a lacquer shop where you can buy some unique souvenirs for friends and family. The tour will end around 17:00 in De Tham street – Pham Ngu Lao Street. Have dinner on your account.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 14: Cao Dai Temple – Cu Chi Tunnel Half Day (B/L)

Have Breakfast at your hotel.

08:00–08:30: We will take you to Tay Ninh – a province 95 km South East of HCMC, close to the border with Cambodia. The Cao Dai Temple is often called a 'Walt Disney' fantasia of the East. Its exterior is decorated with multi-colored dragons of all shapes and sizes competing for space with a number of swastikas. Above the main

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entrance is an all-seeing holy eye, the symbol of the Cao Dai sect. The interior is just as engaging containing statues of Jesus Christ, Buddha and the Hindu god, Brahma, all standing side by side.

At about 13.00, following lunch, we will leave Tay Ninh and travel to Cu Chi. Everyone coming to Vietnam should see this fascinating place. It is where guerilla warfare was utilized and perfected. You'll learn all about the intuitive design of the tunnels and a devious use of trap doors. Even with B-52 bombers dropping 30-ton loads of explosive, turning the jungle into a pockmarked moonscape, 30 thousand American troops failed to win over this area! You'll have a good chance to crawl around a portion of the 121 km long, multi-layered tunnel. You'll learn how thousands of guerillas managed to stay unconcealed below ground for many days at a time. There're a lot more to enjoy, and even a real chance to fire real AK bullets!

17:30: Head back to De Tham Street – Pham Ngu Lao Street for dinner on your account.

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 15: Ho Chi Minh – My Tho – Ben Tre – Can Tho (B/L/D)

08:00: Travel by bus to My Tho.

09:30: Board a wooden motor boat to get to Unicorn Island. On this boat trip along the river bank, you'll pass through natural creeks, quiet villages and see rural people going about their daily lives. You will see an interesting fishermen's port made up of stilt houses (half on land, half on water). One of the boat's stops during this trip is at a large orchard that has many different types of tasty tropical fruits for your enjoyment.

Another boat stop is at Turtle Island to board a small rowing boat; you'll see the many interesting transportation modes that local people use to get about. From there, we'll take you to a bee farm for a chance to try a cup of authentic honey tea whilst checking out the folk music that is typical only to the people in Southern Vietnam. After that, we'll take you to a famous village where you can smell the flavor of coconut candy being made many yards away. This is a great opportunity to see the diverse and intricately crafted items that local people can make out of coconut.

As your journey ends, you will return to My Tho by motorized boat and then travel to Can Tho. Overnight in Can Tho.

Day 16: Can Tho – Phong Dien – Cai Rang floating market – Chau Doc (B/L/D)

After breakfast, board a motor boat for a long distance trip to discover the area's largest marketplace...on water! Then cruise through some small channels to visit a famous rice noodle making village with its large rice mill, and more fruit gardens.

Experience the short climb to "Monkey Bridge" in the Delta. Visit another floating marketplace and its surroundings before breaking for lunch and getting a bus to Chau Doc via Long Xuyen to visit a crocodile farm! Arriving in Chau Doc we visit the sacred Sam Mountain for its panoramic views over the vast plains into Cambodia.

Overnight in Chau Doc.

Day 17: Chau Doc – Cambodia/Phnom Penh (B/L)

Have breakfast in the hotel.

07:30: Take boat trip to Cambodia – Phnom Penh.

13:30 – 14:00: Arrive in Phnom Penh Port.

We will collect you with your name on a board. Then transfer you to our proposed hotel. Have lunch & dinner on your account.

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Overnight in Phnom Penh City.

Day 18: Phnom Penh (B/L/D)

After having breakfast at the hotel, visit the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda, and Wat Phnom. Do some shopping at the Russian Market then have lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon visit Toul Sleng and the Genocide Museum, then continue on to The Killing Fields 15 km from Phnom Penh.

Enjoy a delicious dinner and stay overnight in Phnom Penh city.

Day 19: Phnom Penh – Siem Reap (B/L/D)

After breakfast, continue the journey by express A/C coach to Siem Reap. Check in to the hotel, after lunch, transfer to visit Les Artisan D'Angkor and the Handicraft center to see the wood and stone carving process. Then, transfer to enjoy the view of a sunset over Angkor Wat on the top of the Bakheng hill. Have dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight in Siem Reap city.

Day 20: Siem Reap (B/L/D)

After breakfast at the hotel, we visit The Southern Gate of Angkor Thom including the Bayon, Baphoun, the Elephant, the Leper King Terrace and Phimeanakas then head on to Ta Prohm. After lunch, enjoy some shopping at a local market. In the afternoon continue on to visit the Ta Keo, Thommanan, Chaosay Temples and The World Heritage Site of Angkor Wat, one of the "Seven Wonders" of the world". Enjoy a buffet dinner with the Cambodian Traditional show.

Overnight in the Siem Reap city

Day 21: Siem Reap Departure (B)

Today we bid farewell to Cambodia. After breakfast, you are free in your own time for departure to your next destination. The tour ends here.
