(5 days - Departure date: Daily) (02 nights in Da Nang, 02 nights in Hoi An)

Day 01: Da Nang Arrival (No Meal)

Our driver will pick you up at the airport with your name on a board. Then transfer you to your hotel in Da Nang city. Dinner on your account.

Overnight in Da Nang city

Day 2: Ba Na Hills - "Your road to Heavenly Scenery" (B,L) Breakfast at the hotel.

07:50 - 08:10: Pick up you at the hotel for departure to Ba Na hills

09:00: Arrive at the cable car station. From here you will commence the spectacular journey to the top – seeing luscious jungle with fairy waterfalls sprawling to either side. Experiencing the pristine ecological system of the Ba Na Mountains will leave you with a sense of unforeseeable discovery.

09:30: Visit Le Jardin, old wineries, the remains of French Villas and the Linh Ung pagoda containing a 27m high Buddha statue. Leave Le Jardin for the second cable car station to visit the top of mountain and see the remains of old villas.

11:30: Have lunch at the restaurant.

12:00-14:00: Conquer the Peak of Chua mountain at a height of 1,487m, from here you can view the whole Da Nang city nestling in the clouds. Leaving the peak of Chua mountain we continue on the trail to visit the Dreaming Stream, Rainbow Waterfall, Suspension Bridge, Golden Valley, and the ruined Opera House.

14:00: Return to the cable car station at the foot of Ba Na mountain. Before heading back to Da Nang city.

15:00 - 15:30: Back to your hotel where you will be free for the evening to have dinner on your account.

Overnight in Da Nang city

Day 3: Marble Mountain – Hoi An Ancient Town (B,L)

Marble Mountains is a group of five spectacular hills located just South of Da Nang, on the way to Hoi An. The five marble hills or "mountains" are named after the five elements (Ngũ Hành) of ancient oriental philosophy. The area contains many caves, grottos and Buddhist temples brimming with brilliantly formed natural entrances and tunnels. The temples make this area a popular religious pilgrimage site.

Hoi An Ancient Town is truly one of the most charming and beautiful towns in central Vietnam. The preservation of 18th century architecture and the way of life in the old town continues to lure visitors. Once there, most are captured by its unique atmosphere and sense of tranquility. Hoi An is easy to explore and everyone is welcome. Hoi An Ancient Town was officially listed as a World Heritage Site in December in 1999


Breakfast and check-out.

07:50 - 08:10: Pick up from the hotel for transfer to the Marble Mountains

08:15: Visit the stone-carving village.

08:45: Start the short climb up the Marble Mountains.

10:30: Depart for Hoi An ancient Town



11:30: Have lunch at a local restaurant

13:30: Continue on to visit the Ancient town with its world renowned sites such as The Museum of History, Quang Dong temple, The Chinese Assembly Hall of Phuc Kien, the Japanese bridge, Phung Hung Old house, and the Thang Loi handicraft workshop

14:30: Get on the transport back to your hotel in Hoi An ancient town.

15:00: Arrive & check-in after which you are free for dinner on your account.

Overnight in Hoi An city.

Day 4: My Son Holly Land (B,L)

My Son Holy land - a uniquely beautiful sanctuary world of the ancient Chăm religion, has grown in popularity over the preceding years: for good reason! Located 60 km from Da Nang, My Son is the former capital of the ancient Cham civilization that ruled Central Vietnam from the second to the thirteenth century. My Son is considered to be one of the best-preserved Cham structures in Vietnam. This site is a Must-See for those people who are interested in architecture and ancient civilizations and is now one of five UNESCO World Heritage sites in Vietnam.

Breakfast at hotel.

07:50 - 08:10: Pick up from your hotel for transfer to My Son Holy Land

09:15: Arrive at My Son forest. Take a walking tour to visit the legendary complex of the Champa royal worshipping towers and temples before enjoying a Champa musical performance.

12:30: Have a lunch of local food

15:00: Return to your hotel. You are free to have dinner at your account.

Overnight in Hoi An city.

Day 5: Hoi An - Da Nang departure (B)

After breakfast. You will be free for some shopping in Hoi An ancient town. Then our driver will see you to the airport 3 hours prior to departure time where the tour finishes.
